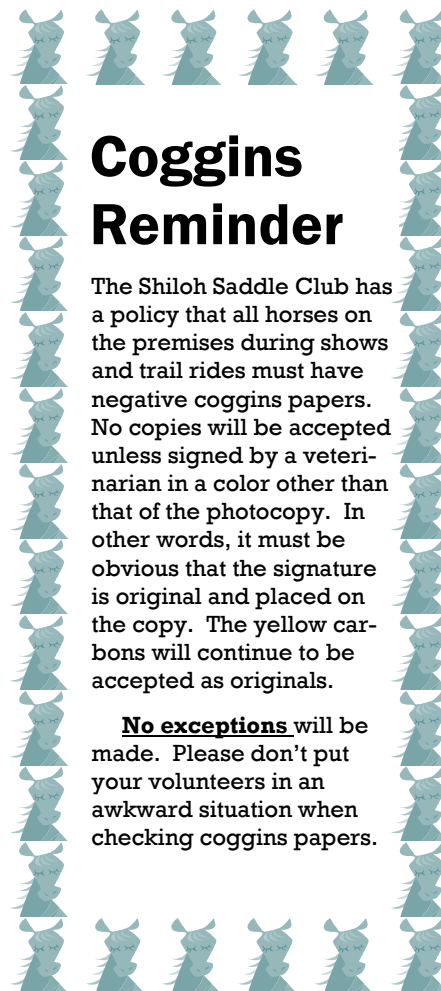

Coggins Reminder

The Shiloh Saddle Club has a policy that all horses on the premises during shows and trail rides must have negative coggins papers. No copies will be accepted unless signed by a veterinarian in a color other than that of the photocopy. In other words, it must be obvious that the signature is original and placed on the copy. The yellow carbons will continue to be accepted as originals.

No exceptions will be made. Please don't put your volunteers in an awkward situation when checking coggins papers.
